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

2. Medical records


Practise vocabulary from a medical record and exchanging information with a patient.

In this section you will practise greetings and asking questions, learn vocabulary and practise spelling, then practise saying days and dates.



Section 2: Medical records




In this section you will practise vocabulary from a medical record, then practise asking for and giving information about a patient.

3. A physical examination




In this section you will learn and practise vocabulary of parts of the body, then watch videos and practise language of giving instructions during a physical examination.

Section 4: Asking about symptoms




In this section you will study vocabulary and ways of describing symptoms, then practise asking a patient about symptoms.

Test 4 This section tests what you have studied in section 4, "Asking about symptoms". You will receive a mark out of 10 for this test which will contribute to your final assessment.




Section 5: Prescribing treatment

Section 6: Outpatient service



Test 6 This section tests what you have studied in section 6, "Outpatient service". You will receive a mark out of 10 for this test which will contribute to your final assessment.







This very useful tool allows you to select and listen to words or text anywhere on the page. Alternatively, you can copy in your own text and listen to it.


